This letter is written to advise you that the denial of initial accreditation of California College of Music by the Accrediting Commission of the Accrediting Council for Continuing Education & Training (ACCET) is now a final action. A letter was sent to the institution on September 3, 2010, received on September 7, 2010, informing you of the decision to deny accreditation to the institution, with the opportunity to appeal if received within 15 days of receipt, in accordance with ACCET policy. No appeal has been received as of this date; therefore, the institution's decision not to seek an appeal exhausts the available administrative remedies provided by the Commission and makes this action final. The institution may submit an official comment for posting with regard to the Commission's decision, provided it is received within 15 days of receipt of this letter.
